Dear Ms. Conner:

Reference is made to your letter dated October 30, 2003 providing the additional information that was requested. We have reviewed the accident data you provided and the revised parameters for the speed zones. The accident data revealed that the majority of the accidents were rear end type accidents, with minor or no injuries resulting from these accidents.

Based on the findings from our reviews the Department will agree to place the portion of Marietta Street from Brownsville Road to New Macland Road, as originally requested, on your speed detection device permit at 25 MPH. **The approval of this reduction by the Georgia Department of Transportation, does not relieve the City of its obligation to comply with Georgia Code Section 40-6-183,** but merely approves the roadway for speed detection device usage.

Please look over the enclosed List of Roadways and advise if there are any corrections necessary. This is the current format required by the Department of Public Safety. The only change we're allowed to make in regards to the format of this document is the number of signatures on the signature page. If you are in agreement with this List of Roadways please have it approved by the City Council.

After approval by the City Council *please forward to this office a signed copy* of the List of Roadways and we will forward it to the Department of Public Safety for issuance of an updated Speed Detection Device Permit.
